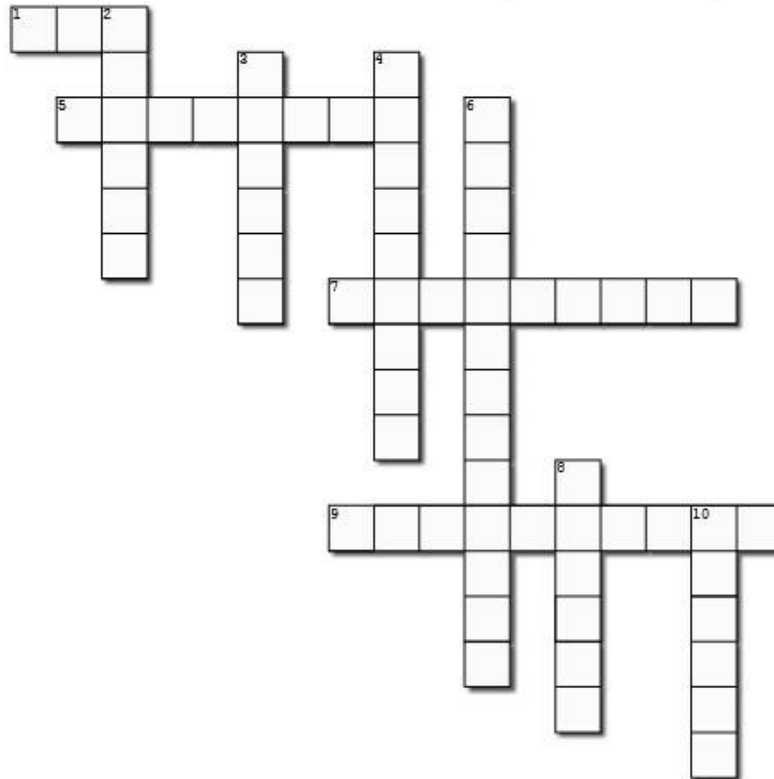
Thomas Sowell
