# Civics TRIVIA

## **What do the 50 stars on the U.S. flag represent?**

The 50 stars on the United States flag represent the 50 states.

## **Who does a U.S. Senator represent?**

A U.S. Senator represents ALL people of the state they are elected in.

## **What are the two parts of the U.S. Congress?**

Congress is divided into two institutions: the House of Representatives and the Senate.

## **What are the first ten amendments to the Constitution called?**

The first ten amendments to the Constitution are called the Bill of Rights.

## **What is a responsibility of a United States citizen?**

U.S. citizens have important rights and responsibilities including the right to vote in federal elections and the ability to serve on a jury.

## **What is the highest court in the United States?**

The Supreme Court of the United States is the highest court in the land and the only part of the federal judiciary specifically required by the Constitution.

## **Who has the power to sign bills to become laws?**

The President can approve the bill and sign it into law.

## **How many voting members does the U.S. House of Representatives have?**

Currently the U.S. House of Representatives has 435 voting members.

## **Who is in charge of the executive branch of government?**

The President of the United States is in charge of the executive branch of the federal government.

## **Who is the Commander in Chief of the military?**

The President is Commander in Chief of all the armed forces of the United States.
